in their efforts to assert dominion over vast reaches of the now u s southwest in the seventeenth century the spanish built a series of far flung missions and presidios at strategic locations one of the most important of these was san juan bautista del río grande located at the present day site of guerrero in coahuila mexico despite its significance as the main entry point into spanish texas during the colonial period san juan bautista was generally forgotten until the first publication of this book in 1968 weddle s narrative is a fascinating chronicle of the many religious military colonial and commerical expeditions that passed through san juan and a valuable addition to knowledge of the spanish borderlands it won the texas institute of letters amon g carter award for best southwest history in 1969

nativos sino también a la salud espiritual de los habitantes de la colonia la metrópoli deseaba que la sociedad colonial emulara lo más posible a su contraparte europea organizó una burocracia encabezada por el gobernador y el intendente envió mujeres y ofreció beneficios a quienes procrearan hijos con la esperanza de poblar la colonia con fieles súbditos de la corona francesa sin embargo el señorío no permaneció inmune a su nuevo contexto la presencia de indígenas amigables y hostiles las características propias del entorno el río san lorenzo y los espesos bosques el comercio de pieles que atraía a numerosos individuos que más que convertirse en agricultores anhelaban amasar una fortuna mediante otros medios así como las ambiciones coloniales de otras potencias lo transformaron de manera irrevocable fue así que la colonia quedó a merced de presiones internas y externas que tuvieron un fuerte impacto en su devenir es pues el propósito en este libro revisar las diversas etapas de la colonización que dio origen a nueva francia y su tránsito de un enclave peletero a una colonia formal en la que coexistían tanto rasgos propios de la metrópoli como los originados en el escenario americano algunos de los cuales perviven hasta la actualidad
