eight teacher counselors five education officers and three hundred and fourteen students the study area was bungoma west sub county questionnaires interview schedules and observation checklist were blended together to capture exhaustive data quantitative data collected was sorted classified and analyzed using descriptive statistical techniques qualitative data was recorded in verbatim transcribed and organized into themes and sub themes the study revealed that the school administration has a direct influence in promotion of guidance and counseling services in schools through appointment of heads of department to co ordinate counseling activities as well as the counseling committee provision of basic counseling facilities advocacy and publicity of the services and monitoring and evaluation however it was also revealed that in many schools the administration accords low priority to guidance and counseling services since many schools lacked basic facilities for guidance and counseling like offices and reference materials teachers in charge of guidance and counseling are overloaded with their teaching subjects and emphasis is put on attainment of good mean grades it is recommended that there is urgent need for the school administration to prioritize counseling services of all categories of learners as they go hand in hand with holistic development of the learners the ministry of education should put disciplinary measures against school administrators who do not implement viable and sustainable guidance and counseling services that cater for all learners in secondary schools
