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a vocabulary around covid 19 acute respiratory distress syndrome or ards for short refers to a type of lung damage that can result from a variety of causes including illness trauma or even as a complication that occurs following certain medical procedures acute respiratory distress syndrome ards is a type of respiratory failure characterized by rapid onset of widespread inflammation in the lungs 1 symptoms include shortness of breath dyspnea rapid breathing tachypnea and bluish skin coloration cyanosis 1 for those who survive a decreased quality of life is common 4 ards is a severe lung condition that occurs when fluid fills up the air sacs in your lungs it can be caused by various factors such as toxic substances infections or injuries symptoms include shortness of breath gasping for air and low blood oxygen treatment involves oxygen medication and ventilation respiratory distress syndrome rds is a relatively common condition that occurs in preterm neonates resulting from insufficient production of surfactant terminology acute respiratory distress syndrome ards is a common clinical syndrome of acute respiratory failure as a result of diffuse lung inflammation and oedema ards can be precipitated by a variety of causes the acute respiratory distress syndrome ands is a common cause of respiratory failure in critically ill patients and is defined by the acute onset of noncardiogenic pulmonary oedema neonatal respiratory distress syndrome rds is a problem often seen in premature babies the condition makes it hard for the baby to breathe causes neonatal rds occurs in infants whose lungs have not yet fully developed the disease is mainly caused by a lack of a slippery substance in the lungs called surfactant infant respiratory distress syndrome irds also called respiratory distress syndrome of newborn or increasingly surfactant deficiency disorder sdd 2 and previously called hyaline membrane disease hmd is a syndrome in premature infants caused by developmental insufficiency of pulmonary surfactant production and structural immatur

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
