One Jump Ahead 2008-12-16 it's hard to believe that it's been over a decade since one jump ahead challenging human supremacy at checkers was published i'm delighted to have the opportunity to update and expand the book the first edition ended on a sad note and that was reflected in the writing it is now eleven years later and the project has come to a satisfying conclusion since its inception the checkers project has consumed eighteen years of my life twenty if you count the pre-chinook and post-solving work it's hard for me to believe that i actually stuck with it for that long my wife steph would probably have something witty to say about my obsessive behavior rereading the book after a decade was difficult for me when i originally wrote one jump ahead i vowed to be candid in my telling of the story that meant being honest about what went right and what went wrong i have been criticized for being hard on some of the characters that may be so but i hope everyone will agree that the person receiving the most criticism was justifiably me i tried to be balanced in the storytelling reflecting things as they really happened and not as some sanitized everyone lived happily ever after tale
