on march 9 1878 three men were murdered in isolated blackwater canyon in new mexico the suspects were billy the kid and a number of his regulators this action almost assuredly taken in retaliation for the death of the kid s friend john henry tunstall became the real catalyst in the lincoln county war in 2006 the author and a team of investigators searched for the remains of the men and related artifacts in the obscure canyon the first to do so since the murders the murders were reconstructed with the discovery of over thirty bullet cartridges as part of the reconstruction of the crime the author widens the scope of his investigation by examining the lives and paths of all three victims william s buck morton a virginian fleeing from his past frank baker a mystery man who hid his real name and shady career and william mccloskey an elderly cowboy who unsuccessfully attempted to play the peacemaker the myths and accounts of the three men and their murders are analytically separated connective events where the paths of the participants intersected such as the death of john tunstall are likewise examined legend and fact are separated in the case and its participants both victims and suspects billy the kid is justly portrayed as a human being wrought by conflicts the regulators and their opposition reveal character both good and bad an investigative approach to this portion of the billy the kid saga corrects the record on some old assumptions and creates new avenues of insight and possibility

a native georgian james hughes callahan 1812 1856 migrated to texas to serve in the texas revolution in exchange for land in seguin texas where he settled he met and married a divorcée sarah medissa day 1822 1856 the lives of these two texas pioneers and their extended family would become so entwined in the events and experiences of the nascent nation and state that their story represents a social history of nineteenth century texas from his arrival as a sergeant with the georgia battalion through the ill fated 1855 expedition that bears his name to his shooting death in a feud with a neighbor callahan was a soldier a texas ranger a rancher and a land developer at every turn making his mark on the evolving guadalupe river basin separately sarah s family s journey reflected the experience of many immigrants to texas after its war of independence thomas o mcdonald traces the pair s respective paths to their meeting then follows as together they contend with conflict troublesome social mores the emergence of new industries and the taming of the land along the way helping to shape the texas culture we know today with a sharp eye for character and detail and with a wealth of material at his command author thomas o mcdonald tells a story as crackling with life as it is steeped in scholarly research in these pages the lives of the callahan and day families become a canvas on which the history of texas from revolution frontier defense and indian wars to anglo settlement and emerging legal and social systems

bureau is the leading source of quality data about the nation's people and economy the bureau of labor statistics bls is the principal federal agency responsible for measuring labor market activity working conditions and price changes in the economy together these agencies produce a wealth of information about the american workforce this book includes information about the jobs that people hold the occupations that they pursue the industries where they work and the education levels that people have attained in addition to tables each section also includes relevant figures and highlights of notable data some examples of interesting data found inside education and the american workforce include with no formal educational requirement and a median salary of 22 680 4 5 million people are employed as retail salespersons the most of any single occupation cashiers and food preparation serving workers account for another 3 5 million each there are 2 9 million registered nurses the most numerous of occupations that require a bachelor's degree the biggest numeric decline is expected for postal service mail carriers dropping by about 78 000 in ten years when combined with other postal service occupations such as clerks sorters postmasters and others a decline of 140 000 jobs is expected for the postal service among the 75 largest counties bronx county ny had the highest number of residents age 25 and over with less than a high school diploma at 29 4 percent while montgomery county pa had the lowest percentage at 6 2 percent meanwhile new york county ny and fairfax county va had the highest percentage of residents with a bachelor's degree or higher at 59 9 percent followed by montgomery county md at 57 9 percent among the 75 largest counties nationally between 2011 and

2015 29.8 percent of the population had a bachelor's degree or higher

Archie Burrow desperado is the factual story of a prolific train robber in the 1880s and 1890s who briefly captured national attention through his daring deeds his robberies ranged from Texas to Arkansas to Mississippi and Alabama the state where he was raised he topped off his criminal career with a cold blooded murder that triggered a major manhunt Burrow managed to pull off a number of amazing escapes from his pursuers finally resulting in the inevitable violent end various writers attempted to write about him and his deeds but often getting the facts wrong through diligent research Rick Miller has laid out the true story from primary sources correcting the many errors written about Burrow and his cohorts while Burrow did not achieve the lasting notoriety of Jesse James Butch Cassidy or Billy the Kid his story is as exciting and interesting as his outlaw counterparts
